In addition, TNDC provides support services to help residents stabilize their lives and develop a sense of community, including a team of 19 on-site social workers, the free Tenderloin After-School Program (TASP) for neighborhood children, and a Community Organizing program to encourage residents to get involved in making positive change in the Tenderloin.
