As San Francisco experiences a severe housing crisis, TNDC's mission—equitable access to opportunity and resources through affordable housing and services—is even more pressing. And with the region's escalating land and construction costs, it is more challenging. Those on the lowest end of the economic scale have been most adversely affected by this housing crisis.

In the context of the housing crisis, land use decisions have become a crucial issue in the communities in which TNDC works. For the first time in decades, new market-rate housing is financially viable in the Tenderloin, and in 2015, we responded by getting more involved in local land use and community planning issues.

TNDC is on a path to build or preserve a dozen more properties, increasing its homes under management from by almost 1,000 to 3,700 in 2021.

The organization thrives today because of the efforts of the generation before us and will thrive tomorrow because of you. We hope you will continue your connection and support of our work to meet the growing needs of our community.
